Teaching Purpose	After completing this training, the students should be able to: - Learn global industry codes, terminology, definitions; interpret flight schedules; understand baggage allowance; perceive airline ancillaries service, identify aircraft types; learn international laws and regulations applicable to the airline industry. - Through simulated GDS training, students perform basic entries and commands to retrieve information, create transactions to make reservations of airlines, hotels plus car rentals, and learn to interpret all-screen displays for Amadeus global distribution systems used by travel agents and airlines around the world.
Course Content	This is a “Global Distribution System-GDS” (Electronic Booking Tool-EBT in IATA) training course for a sophomore at an international bachelor program in tourism management. This course is designed for students who plan to explore their careers in the travel service and aviation industry. The course will include an understanding of the travel and airline industry, the practicalities of the travel professionals’ role in this industry, and professional skill for itineraries building and pricing exercises through the GDS.
